**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO USE ELECTRONIC SERVICE  
OF PLEADINGS AND NOTICES**

The Court considered the SDR's *Application to Use Electronic Service of Pleadings and Notices* ("Application"). Having considered the Application, the Court finds that the Application is meritorious, in the best interests of the receivership estate and should be granted.


Having considered the Application, the Court finds as follows:

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this application under TEX. INS. CODE ANN. Chapter 443;
2. The Order of Reference to Master ("Order of Reference") entered by this Court on January 26, 2009 provides that applications filed pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE ANN. § 443.151 are referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding;
3. The Application was submitted to the Special Master in accordance with the Order of Reference;
4. Notice of the Application was provided in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE ANN. §443.007 (d) and the Order of Reference, and no objections to the Application were filed;
5. The Special Master has issued a recommendation that the Application should be granted pursuant to Rule 171 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure; and
6. The recommendation of the Special Master should be confirmed, and the Application should be GRANTED.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:


1. The Application is approved in all respect;
2. The SDR and all other parties at interest and parties requesting notice shall file any pleading, plea, motion, applications, notice and all other matters requiring service by email;
3. The SDR shall, by its counsel, Brian E. Riewe, of Brian E. Riewe, P.C., whose email address is [briewe@riewelaw.com](mailto:briewe@riewelaw.com) create and maintain a current list of email addresses of all parties and provide the list and a copy of this Order to all parties in interest and parties requesting notice;
4. All parties at interest and parties requesting notice shall provide to the SDR's counsel its email address;
5. The SDR may, at its discretion, serve pleadings or notices by any other means authorized by TEX. INS. CODE ANN. § 443.007, the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure or other order of this Court; and
6. Granting the SDR such other and further relief to which it may be justly entitled.
