**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY TO
ABANDON AGENCY LICENSE**

On this day came on to be heard the *Application for Authority to Abandon Agency License* filed by Jennifer Ramsey, PC, Special Deputy Receiver (“SDR”). The SDR appeared by and through its counsel and represented to the Court that it is in the best interest of the receivership estate and its policyholders and creditors to approve the Application.

Having considered the pleadings and the recommendations of the Master acting under the *Order of Reference to Master* entered on January 26, 2009 (“Order of Reference”) the Court finds as follows:

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of the Application under TEX. INS. CODE ANN. § 443.005(c);
2. The Order of Reference provides that applications filed pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE ANN. § 443.154 and that will abandon property are referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding;
3. The Application was submitted to the Special Master in accordance with the Order of Reference;
4. Notice of the submission of the Application to all persons who have requested to be placed on the Certificate of Service was provided in accordance with the requirements of TEX. INS.

CODE ANN. § 443.007 and the notice requirements in the Order of Reference, and no objections to the Application were filed;

5. Notice of the submission of the Application was provided to all persons with an interest in Southern Star Title Company, LLC in the manner shown on the Certificate of Service in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE ANN. § 443.007(d) and the Order of Reference.

6. Notice of the submission of the Application was provided to all parties in interest as that term is defined in TEXAS INS. CODE ANN. § 443.004(17)(a) as shown on the Certificate of Service and is sufficient;


7. The Special Master has issued a recommendation that the Application should be granted pursuant to Rule 171 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure; and

8. The recommendation of the Special Master should be confirmed, and the Application should be granted in all respects.


It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:
